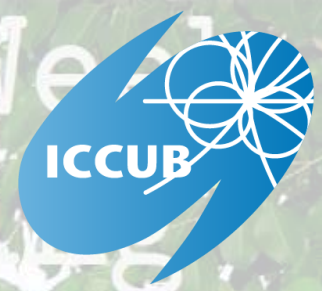

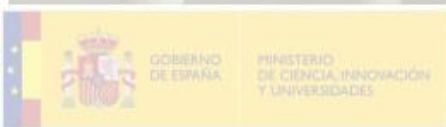

Outreach/Visibility



- In spite of initial success, the impact towards other communities is rather limited:
 - Review papers addressed to particular communities **written** in their language and published in their publications
 - For each scientific community few key people (early adopters) and use cases should be **identified**.
 - Effort should be done to **cite** (as appropriate) work from Computer Scientists (not current leaders but future ones).
 - Key papers and reviews should be listed in the web site, so that newcomers can **find/read/cite** them.



Dynamisation

- Considering organizing the BWMC at different locations every 2-3 years
 - Local organizing committee can not fully enjoy the participation
 - After so many iterations there is not much else to be seen
- Efforts to get students, might be a good idea to address Masters students from other domains (Physics, Biology, Sociology, etc.)
