**longitude: 24.68156 E**

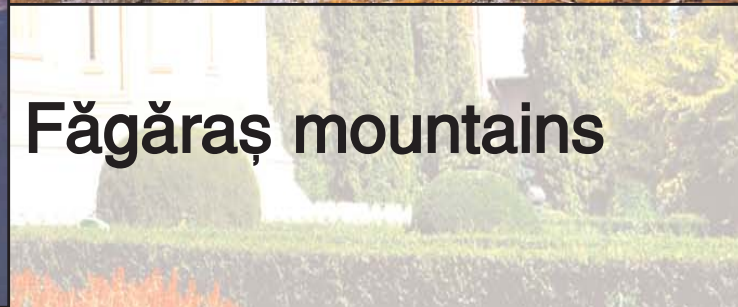
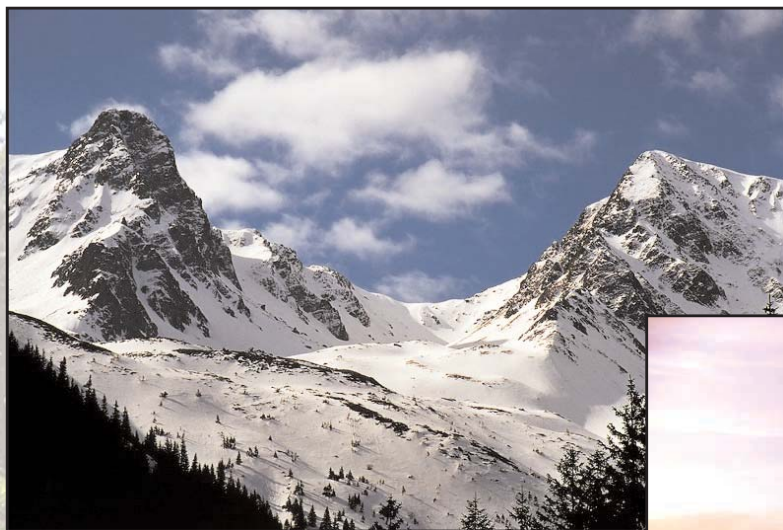
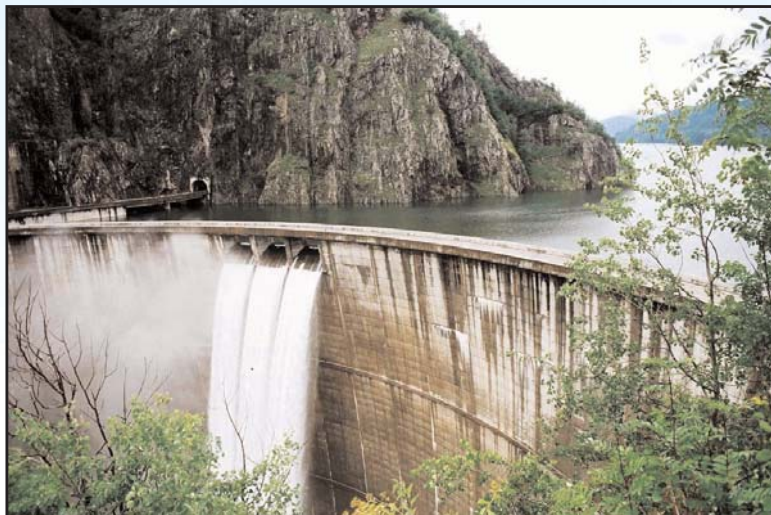
**altitude: 457 m**

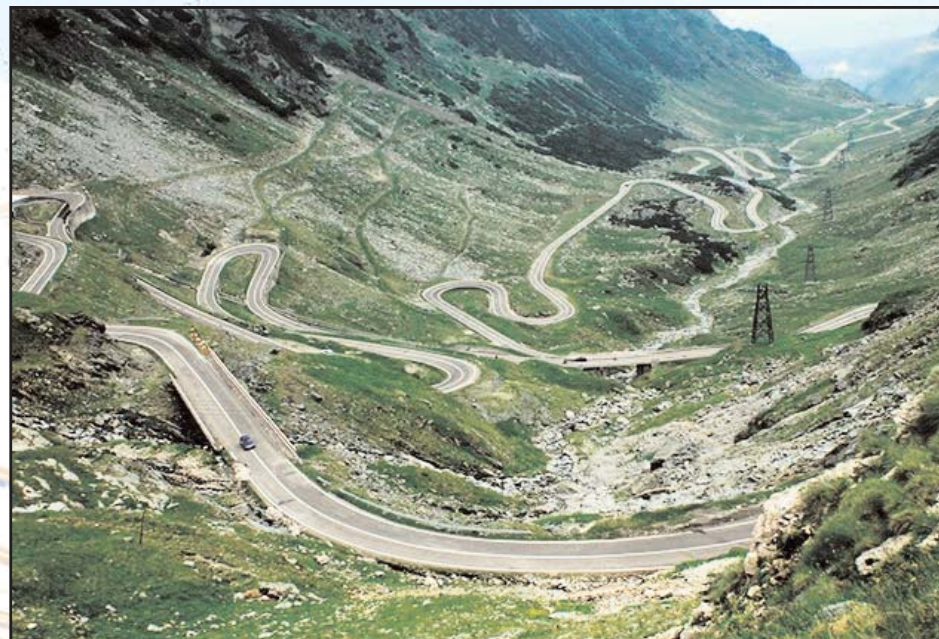
